A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the lands described in the Schedule hereto were, by an order of the Native Land Court made on the seventh day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three, duly laid out as road-lines in pursuance of sections four hundred and seventy-eight and four hundred and seventy-nine of the Native Land Act, 1931:

And whereas the said Court is of the opinion that it is in the public interest that the said road-lines should be proclaimed as public roads, and a notification to that effect has been forwarded to the Minister of Lands, in terms of section four hundred and eighty-six of the said Act:

And whereas one month's notice in writing of the intention to proclaim the said road-lines as public roads has been given by the Surveyor-General to the local authority of the district concerned, in terms of subsection two of section four hundred and eighty-seven of the said Act:

And whereas it is now expedient that the said road-lines should be proclaimed as public roads:

Now, therefore, I, Charles, Baron Bledisloe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section four hundred and eighty-seven of the Native Land Act, 1931, do hereby proclaim as public roads the road-lines described in the Schedule hereto.
