Defining River and Extended-river Limits.

Marine Department,  
 Wellington, 3rd May, 1935.

IN pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon me by section 189 of the Shipping and Seamen Act, 1908, I, John George Cobbe, Minister of Marine, do hereby define the limits for the port set forth in the first column of the Schedule hereto, within which restricted limit steamships and ships propelled by gas, oil, fluid, electricity, or any mechanical power other than steam, and to which restricted-limit certificates are issued, may ply, to be those set forth in the second and third columns of the said Schedule respectively, and I do divide such limits into river and extended-river limits respectively.

(All distances are in nautical miles, and all bearings are true.)

Name of Port.	River and Smooth Water Limits.	Extended River and partially Smooth Water Limits.
Mangawai ..	Inside the Mangawai (Mangawhai) Heads	Within a radius of ten miles of the Mangawai (Mangawhai) North Head. Seasonal: For vessels engaged in deep-sea sports-fishing only:— From 1st May to 31st October— Between a line drawn 090° from the shore, passing through and extending 15 miles from north-eastern end of Wide Berth Island and a line drawn 090° for 12 miles from Bream Tail. From 1st November to 30th April— Between a line drawn 090° from the shore, passing through and extending 25 miles from north-eastern end of Wide Berth Island and a line drawn 090° for 20 miles from Bream Tail.
