RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

Conversion Order No. 1, 1934.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by Part II of the Local Authorities Interest Reduction and Loans Conversion Act, 1932-33, and the Upper Hutt Borough Loans Conversion Order, 1934, the Upper Hutt Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—
