Portion of Land set apart as Provisional State Forest declared to be subject to the Land Act, 1924.

A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section twenty of the Forests Act, 1921-22, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Lands, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto, being portion of a provisional State forest set apart by Proclamation dated the eighteenth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, and gazetted on the twentieth day of that month, as amended by Proclamation dated the sixth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, and gazetted on the ninth day of that month, is required for settlement purposes; and, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act, such land shall, from and after the day of the gazettement hereof, cease to be provisional State forest, and shall become subject to the provisions of the Land Act, 1924.

SCHEDULE.

GISBORNE LAND DISTRICT.

ALL that area containing by admeasurement 7 acres 3 roods 16 perches, more or less, being part Section 5, Block I, Ngatapa Survey District: Commencing at the junction of two public roads forming the north-west corner of Section 5, Block I, Ngatapa Survey District; bounded towards the north-east by a public road 116.2, 310.1, and 259.5 links; towards the south-east by a line 1232.3 links; towards the south-west by a line 561.9 links; and towards the north-west by a public road 1560 links to the point of commencement: be all the aforesaid linkages more or less. As the same is more particularly delineated on a plan marked L. and S. X/102/1A, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon edged red. (Gisborne No. C.P. 3946.)
