A PROCLAMATION.

BY virtue and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section eighteen of the Forests Act, 1921-22, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby set apart the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto as a permanent State forest.

AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT.—ROTORUA FOREST-CONSERVATION REGION.

ALL that area in the Auckland Land District, containing by admeasurement 1,342 acres 2 roods 32 perches, more or less, and being Section 3, Block I, Tuhingamata East Survey District, and Pakuri B Block. As the same is more particularly delineated on the plan No. 46/24, deposited in the Head Office of the State Forest Service at Wellington, and thereon edged red.
