N pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon him by the Board of Trade Act, 1919, and of every other power and authority enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby, on the recommendation of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, make the following Board of Trade regulations for the regulation and control of bread prices.

REGULATIONS.

These regulations may be cited as the Board of Trade (Bread-price) Regulations, 1936.
 In these regulations, unless the context otherwise

"Minister" means the Minister of Industries and

Commerce:
"Sale by retail" means every sale, other than a sale made by wholesale, and includes a sale made

sale made by wholesale, and includes a sale made to any person for any purpose other than resale: "Sale by wholesale" means every sale made to any person for the purpose of resale.

3. The price of bread shall be the standard price thereof on the 8th day of February, 1936—that is to say, in respect of every locality the current price at which on that day bread of the same nature and quality was saleable in that locality when sold in the same quantity and on the same terms as to payment, delivery, and otherwise; and otherwise:
