*Order in Council varying the Determinations in respect of the Balance (£130,000) of the Dunedin City Council's Loan of £180,000 by prescribing Repayment on the Instalment-repayment system.*

THE HON. M. J. SAVAGE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by Order in Council made on the fourth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five, and subject to the determinations as to borrowing and repayment therein set out, consent was given to the raising by the Dunedin City Council (hereinafter called "the said local authority") of the sum of one hundred and eighty thousand pounds (£180,000) by a loan to be known as "Waterworks Loan, 1933" (hereinafter called "the said loan") :

And whereas the sum of one hundred and thirty thousand pounds (£130,000) (hereinafter called "the said sum"), being the balance of the said loan, has not yet been raised, and it is expedient to vary the determinations aforesaid in respect thereof by prescribing repayment on the instalment-repayment system :

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, and in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on him by section eleven of the Local Government Loans Board Act, 1926, as set out in section twenty-nine of the Finance Act, 1932 (No. 2), and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby vary the determinations aforesaid in respect of the said sum by prescribing that the said local authority may, in lieu of making provision for the repayment thereof by the establishment of a sinking fund, raise the said sum or any part thereof upon terms of making the same, together with interest thereon at a rate not exceeding three pounds ten shillings (£3 10s.) per centum per annum, repayable by equal aggregate annual or half-yearly instalments extending over a period of twenty-five (25) years.
