Classification of Roads in Buller and Grey Counties.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on me by the Transport Department Act, 1929, and the Heavy Motor-vehicle Regulations, 1932, I, Robert Semple, Minister of Transport, do hereby approve of the Main Highways Board's proposed alteration in the classification of the roads described in the Schedule hereto and situated in the Buller and Grey Counties.

SCHEDULE.

BULLER AND GREY COUNTIES.

ROADS classified in Class Three: Available for the use thereon of any heavy motor-vehicle (other than a multi-axled heavy motor-vehicle) which, with the load it is carrying, weighs not more than 6½ tons, or any multi-axled heavy motor-vehicle which, with the load it is carrying, weighs not more than 10 tons:—

- Westport-Karamea Main Highway No. 105 (that portion within Buller County between the Mokihinui River Bridge and the Little Karamea River Bridge).
 Westport-Greymouth via Coast Main Highway No. 166 (that portion within Buller and Grey Counties between Charleston and the northern boundary of Runanga Borough).
