

Altering the Boundaries of the Taranaki Electric-power District.

A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the Electric-power Boards Act, 1925, and of all other powers in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby alter the boundaries of the Taranaki Electric-power District so as to include the area described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that area of land situated in the Land District of Taranaki comprising that portion of the County of Inglewood bounded as follows: Commencing at the north-eastern corner of Block VI, Huiroa Survey District, and proceeding thence southerly along the eastern boundary of that block to the northern boundary of Kupara Road; thence easterly along that boundary to the western boundary of the Motukawa Road; thence northerly along that boundary to the northern boundary of Block VII; thence north-easterly generally by that boundary to the western bank of the Waitara River; thence south-easterly by that bank to the confluence of that river with the Makino Stream; thence south-westerly by the north-western bank of that stream to the southern boundary of Block VII at the north-eastern corner of Section 25, Block XII; thence westerly by the southern boundary of the said Block VII to the eastern boundary of Mana Road; thence southerly along that boundary to the southern boundary of the Makara Road; thence north-westerly generally by that boundary to the north-western boundary of Ratapiko Road, and by that boundary to the western boundary of Tariki Road; thence northerly by that boundary to the northern boundary of Block VI; thence easterly by that boundary to the point of commencement: all the said blocks being blocks of the Huiroa Survey District. As the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 92203, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, and thereon coloured blue.
