INVERCARGILL CITY COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Invercargill City Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of principal, interest, and other charges on the Invercargill City Council Redemption Loan, 1936, of £3,400 authorized to be raised by the Invercargill City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of redeeming the outstanding liability (after allowing for accumulated sinking funds) in respect to the Harbour Loan of £5,000 and the Lindisfarne Loans of £1,000 and £600 respectively, the said Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of decimal nought six three of a penny (0.063d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the City of Invercargill, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable on the first day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twelve years or until the loan is fully paid off.”
