W HEREAS it has been found desirable for the use, convenience, and enjoyment of the Springfield to Brunnerton Railway to take further land between Aratika and Kaimata in addition to land previously acquired for the

Now, therefore, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on me by sections thirty-four and two hundred and sixteen of the Public Works Act 1028, and of arow other neuron and authorities in any rise Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes above mentioned.
