A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by subsection nine of section twelve of the Land Act, 1924, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that from and after the date hereof the land comprised in the pieces of closed road described in the First Schedule hereto, being land which intersects the endowment for primary education described in the Second Schedule hereto, shall be deemed to be added to the said endowment.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

ALL those areas in the Hawke's Bay Land District, containing by admeasurement 5 acres 2 roods 27 perches and 18 acres 0 roods 34 perches, more or less, being Section 25R, Block II, and Section 3R, Block III, respectively, Moeangiangi Survey District. As the same are more particularly delineated on the plan marked L. and S. 20/87A, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon edged red.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

BY virtue and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section eighteen of the Forests Act, 1921-22, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby set apart the national-endowment land described in the Schedule hereto as a provisional State forest.

SCHEDULE.

NELSON LAND DISTRICT.—NELSON FOREST-CONSERVATION REGION.

ALL those areas of national-endowment land in the Nelson Land District described as follows:—

All that area containing by admeasurement 160 acres, more or less, being part of Section 27, Block III, Steeples Survey District, and part of Section 13, Block I, Waitakere Survey District, and bounded generally as follows: Towards the east by other parts of the said Sections 27 and 13; towards the south and west by a road reserve along the Okari River; again towards the west by Sections 11, 2, and 1, Block I, Waitakere Survey District, and the abutment of a road; and again towards the west and towards the north by another part of the said Section 27.

Also all that area containing by admeasurement 10 acres, more or less, being part of Section 18, Block I, Waitakere Survey District, and bounded generally as follows: Towards the north and east by a road reserve along the Okari River; again towards the east and towards the south by another part of the said Section 18; and towards the west by Section 3, Block I, Waitakere Survey District.
