IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Clutha County Council on the twenty-seventh day of October, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, viz. :—

“The Clutha County Council, being the local authority having control of the roads in the Clutha County, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to that portion of road adjoining part Section 10, Block XXXVIII, Clutha District” ;

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the southern side of the portion of road (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of road.

THE southern side of all that portion of road, situated in the Otago Land District, County of Clutha, fronting part Section 10, Block XXXVIII, Clutha Survey District. subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the south-western side of the portion of Queen Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.

“That the Dunedin City Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the City of Dunedin, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the undermentioned portions of streets, viz.—

“(a) The south-western side of portion of Carlyle Street abutting on part Section 1, North-east Valley Survey District ;

“(b) The eastern side of portion of Gladstone Road abutting on part Section 1, North-east Valley Survey District ;”

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the south-western side of the portion of Carlyle Street, or fronting the eastern side of the portion of Gladstone Road (described in the Schedule hereto), within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-lines of the said portions of streets.

SCHEDULE.

THE south-western side of all that portion of street, situated in the Otago Land District, City of Dunedin, known as Carlyle Street, fronting part Section 1, North-east Valley Survey District.

Also the eastern side of all that portion of street, situated in the said land district and city, known as Gladstone Road, fronting part Section 1, North-east Valley Survey District.

As the same are more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 94097, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, and thereon edged red.
