RODNEY COUNTY COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

Makarau Bridge Loan, 1936, of £800.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Rodney County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a loan of £800 authorized to be raised by the Rodney County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of providing the Rodney County Council's share of the cost of the Makarau Bridge, the said Rodney County Council hereby makes and levies a rate of 0.03231517d. in the pound upon the rateable (unimproved) value of all rateable property in the County of Rodney, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the first day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of fifteen years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
