*Notice respecting Proposed Alteration of Boundaries, Thames Valley Drainage District.*

IT is hereby notified that a petition has been presented to His Excellency the Governor-General under the Land Drainage Act, 1908, and amendments, praying that the area described in the Schedule hereto may be included in the Thames Valley Drainage District. All persons affected are hereby called upon to lodge any written objections to or petitions

against the proposed alteration of boundaries which they desire to lodge within one month from the first publication of this notice, such objections or petitions to be addressed to the Minister of Internal Affairs, Wellington.

SCHEDULE.

AREA PROPOSED TO BE INCLUDED IN THAMES VALLEY DRAINAGE DISTRICT, COUNTY OF PIAKO.

ALL that area bounded by a line commencing at a point on the boundary of the Thames Valley Drainage District (*Gazette*, 1933, page 1859), being the northernmost corner of Section 21, Block VII, Waitoa Survey District; thence in a south-westerly direction generally following the Thames Valley Drainage District, along the south-eastern side of the Paeroa-Tahuna Road to the north-western corner of Section 22, Block VII, Waitoa Survey District; thence in a north-easterly direction generally across the Paeroa-Tahuna Road aforesaid, and along the north-western, south-western, again north-western, and northern boundaries of Section 17 of aforesaid Block VII, and the western boundaries of Sections 18, 19, and 20, all of aforesaid Block VII; thence in a south-easterly direction along the north-eastern boundary of Section 20 aforesaid and a right line across the Paeroa-Tahuna Road to the point of commencement.
