NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

The Wellington City Sewerage Loan, 1937.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and its amendments, the Wellington City Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a loan of two hundred thousand pounds (£200,000) to be known as the Wellington City Sewerage Loan, 1937, authorized to be raised by the Wellington City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of carrying out alterations and improvements to the sewerage system, the said Wellington City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one hundred and thirty eight-hundredths of a penny ($\frac{138}{1000}$ d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property of the City of Wellington, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the first day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten (10) years or until the loan is fully paid off.”

The above resolution was duly passed at a meeting of the Wellington City Council held on the 15th day of April, 1937.
