PANMURE TOWNSHIP ROAD BOARD.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Panmure Township Road Board hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the principal, interest, and other charges on a loan of two thousand five hundred pounds (£2,500) authorized to be raised by the Panmure Township Road Board under the above-mentioned Act for the installation of a water-supply system for domestic and fire-fighting purposes and reticulation for the district, the said Panmure Township Road Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of nine-sixteenths of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property of the Panmure Township Road District, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of fifteen years or until the loan is fully paid off.”
