Amendments and additions to rules passed at the annual general meeting of the Stock Exchange Association of New Zealand held in Wellington on 4th November, 1936.

Rule 46: Amend to read:

On Rights to New Issues: Unless authorized to the contrary by the Executive at the time the rights are issued the rates of brokerage shall be-

To Sellers: Rates as above on price of rights.

To Buyers: Rates as above on the price of the rights, plus the amount of calls required to convert them into transferable shares.

Rule 83: Alter the number of days from 14 to 28.

Rule 83 (a): Add the following:—

It shall not be incumbent upon a member to accept a marked transfer of investment shares where there are less than fourteen days in the case of transfers of shares on an Australian Register and seven days in the case of transfers of shares on a New Zealand Register before the expiry of the period for which scrip is being held in support.
