

Revoking Rules for the Examination of Officers of the New Zealand Division of the Royal Naval Volunteer Reserve for Certificates of Efficiency in Navigation.

IN pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon me by section 23 of the Shipping and Seamen Act, 1908, I, Peter Fraser, Minister of Marine, do hereby revoke the Rules for Examination of Officers of the New Zealand Division of the Royal Naval Volunteers' Reserve for Certificates of Efficiency in Navigation, made on the 29th day of December, 1931, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* on the 8th day of January, 1932.

Notice under the Shops and Offices Act, 1921-22, and its Amendments, fixing the Closing-hours of (1) Hairdressers' and (2) Tobacconists' Shops within the Borough of Morrinsville.

WHEREAS a requisition in writing has been forwarded to me from the occupiers of shops in each of the trades of (1) hairdresser and (2) tobacconist within the Borough of Morrinsville pursuant to section 32 of the Shops and Offices Act, 1921-22:

And whereas I, Patrick Charles Webb, Acting Minister of Labour, am satisfied that the signatures to such requisition represent a majority of the occupiers of all the shops in each of the said trades within the said borough:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the said section 32, I do hereby direct that on and after the 7th day of June, 1937, all the shops in each of the said trades within the said borough shall be closed in the evening of working-days as follows: On Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays at 6 p.m., and on Fridays at 10 p.m., with the following exceptions:—

(1) On the evening of the working-day immediately preceding Good Friday, and on the evening of the working-day immediately preceding Anniversary Day, Anzac Day, or King's Birthday, when such day falls on a Friday, the closing-hour shall be 10 p.m.; and

(2) On the evening of the working-day immediately preceding Christmas Day, and on the evening of the working-day immediately preceding New Year's day, the closing-hour shall be 11 p.m.

ROAD classified in Class Three: Available for the use thereon of any heavy motor-vehicle (other than a multi-axled heavy motor-vehicle) which, with the load it is carrying, weighs not more than 6½ tons, or any multi-axled heavy motor-vehicle which, with the load it is carrying, weighs not more than 10 tons:—

Great South Main Highway No. 1 (all that portion from the southern boundary of Hamilton Borough to the southern boundary of Ohaupo Town District).

Prohibition of Issue of Money-orders and Transmission of Postal Correspondence.
