Now, therefore, in pursuance of the said section 32, I do hereby direct that on and after the 21st day of June, 1937, all the said shops within the said borough shall be closed in the evening of working-days as follows: During the periods 1st January to 31st March (both days inclusive) and 1st October to 31st December (both days inclusive), on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays at 8.30 p.m., and on Fridays and Saturdays at 11.10 p.m. During the period 1st April to 30th September (both days inclusive), on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays at 7.30 p.m., and on Fridays and Saturdays at 11.10 p.m., with the following exceptions:—

- (1) During the week in which the Stratford Poultry and Winter Show Association (Inc.) Winter Show is held, the hour of closing on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday shall be 9 p.m.;
- (2) During the period from 11th December to 5th January (both days inclusive), the hour of closing on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays shall be 9.30 p.m.;
- (3) On the working-day immediately preceding Christmas Day and on the working-day immediately preceding New Year's Day there shall be no fixed hour of closing;
- (4) On the 26th December or the day observed as Boxing Day the hour of closing shall be 9 p.m.; and
- (5) On the working-day immediately preceding Good Friday and the working-day immediately preceding Anzac Day, when such day falls on a Friday, the hour of closing shall be 11.10 p.m.
