THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND TRUSTS AMENDMENT BILL, 1937.

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made to the General Assembly of New Zealand in the ensuing session by Herbert Edgar Evans and Ernest Frederic Hadfield, of Wellington, Barristers and Solicitors, and John Newton Stephenson, of Nelson, Diocesan Secretary (hereinafter called "the promoters"), for leave to bring in a Private Bill the short title of which is as above to effect the following objects and purposes, viz. :—

1. To amend section eight of the Church of England Trusts Act, 1913, by adding a proviso to the following effect, viz. :—
" Provided further that notwithstanding anything hereinbefore contained any authority required to be given by such Diocesan Synod to any sale, exchange, or mortgage may be given by such Diocesan Synod itself, or if the Diocesan Synod be not in session, by the Standing Committee of such Diocese."

Printed copies of the proposed Bill will be deposited in the office of the Examiner of Standing Orders at Parliament House, Wellington, not later than fourteen days after the commencement of the session.
