

Declaring Areas to be Closely Populated Localities for the Purposes of the Motor-vehicles Amendment Act, 1936, Section 3.

IN terms of section 3 of the Motor-vehicles Amendment Act, 1936, the Minister of Transport does hereby declare the respective areas described in the Schedule hereto to be closely populated localities for the purposes of the said section to the intent that a person driving any motor-vehicle on any road, street, or other place to which the public have access therein shall be subject to the maximum speed-limit of thirty miles an hour fixed by the said section.

SCHEDULE.

Situated within Waipa County—

All that area adjoining the Great South Road from the northern boundary of the Hamilton Borough as now constituted to the junction of the Great South Road and Forest Lake Road.

All that area adjoining the Great South Road from the southern boundary of the Hamilton Borough as now constituted to a point opposite the southern boundary of the Melville School grounds.

All that area adjoining Hamilton-Raglan Main Highway No. 17 from the western boundary of the Hamilton Borough as now constituted to a point 5 chains measured along the road in a westerly direction from the said boundary.

All that area adjoining Frankton-Pirongia Main Highway No. 466 from the western boundary of the Hamilton Borough as now constituted to a point 18 chains measured along the road in a southerly direction from the said boundary.

All that area adjoining the Great South Road from the northern boundary of the Te Awamutu Borough as now constituted to a point 15 chains measured along the road in a north-westerly direction from the said boundary.

All that area adjoining Te Awamutu-Cambridge Main Highway No. 319 from its junction with the Great South Road near Te Awamutu to its junction with Te Rahu Road.

Situated within Whakatane County—

All that area at Tancatua adjoining the Whakatane-Gisborne via Waioeka State Highway from a point 4 chains measured along the highway in a north-westerly direction from the junction of the State Highway and Howell Road to a point 4 chains measured along the highway in a north-easterly direction from the junction of the State Highway and Ruatoki Road.
