IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in him by the Public Works Act, 1928, the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby authorize the Timaru Borough Council to permit the laying-off of the proposed street described in the Schedule hereto of a width less than sixty-six feet, but not less than forty-nine feet six inches, subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the said street within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said street.

SCHEDULE.

THAT proposed street in the Canterbury Land District, Borough of Timaru, to be known as Wigley Street, containing by admeasurement 1 rood 20-4 perches, more or less, being portion of Lot 24 and part Lot 25, D.P. 512, being part Rural Section 2345. As the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 93325, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, and thereon coloured red.

“The Clutha County Council, being the local authority having control of the roads in the Clutha County, by resolution declares that section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to those portions of roads adjoining Sections 25 and 26, Block III, Greenvale Survey District, and Section 59 and part Section 60, Block III, Glenkenich Survey District” ;
