WHEREAS by Order in Council made on the eighteenth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, and subject to the determinations as to borrowing and repayment therein set out, consent was given to the raising in New Zealand by the Grey Hospital Board (hereinafter called "the said local authority") of the sum of one thousand pounds (£1,000) by a loan to be known as "Alterations and Additions Loan, 1934, No. 2": And whereas the authority conferred by the said Order in Council has not yet been exercised:

(5) The rate payable for brokerage, underwriting, and procuration fees in respect of the borrowing of the said sum or any part thereof shall not in the aggregate exceed one-half per centum of any amount raised.

(6) No moneys shall be borrowed under this consent after the expiration of two years from the date hereof.
