Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 33 of the said Act, I do hereby direct that on and after the 27th day of September, I do hereby direct that on and after the 27th day of September, 1937, the sale of the said goods within the said borough shall be and is hereby prohibited as follows: On Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays after the hour of 6 p.m., and on Fridays and Saturdays after the hour of 11.30 p.m., with the following exceptions—(1) On the workingday immediately preceding Good Friday the sale of the said goods is prohibited after the hour of 11.30 p.m., and on the Saturday immediately following after the hour of 6 p.m.; (2) on the working-day immediately preceding Anniversary Day, Anzac Day, or the King's Birthday, when any such day falls on a Saturday, the sale of the said goods is prohibited after the hour of 11.30 p.m.; (3) on the working-day immediately preceding Christmas Day and on the working-day immediately preceding New Year's Day the sale of the said goods is prohibited after the hour of 11.30 p.m.
