RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

Foreshore Protection Loan, £5,000.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Borough of Oamaru hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing interest and other charges on a loan of five thousand pounds (£5,000) authorized to be raised by the Borough of Oamaru under the above-mentioned Act for foreshore protection, the said Borough of Oamaru hereby makes and levies a special rate of three-quarters of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the Borough of Oamaru comprising the whole of the Borough; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of January in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of fifteen years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
