IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for post and telegraph purposes; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the fifteenth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by subsection nine of section twelve of the Land Act, 1924, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that from and after the date hereof the land comprised in the pieces of closed road and land taken for the purposes of subsection ten of the said section twelve described in the First Schedule hereto, being land which is adjacent to the endowment for primary education described in the Second Schedule hereto, shall be deemed to be added to the said endowment.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

ALL those areas in the North Auckland Land District, Manganui County, containing together 1 acre 1 rood 27 perches, more or less, being Allotments 180, 181, 182, 183, 184, Parish of Mangatete. As the same are more particularly delineated on the plan marked L. and S. 36/1139A, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon edged red.
