## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

*The Wellington City Mercer Street Land Purchase Loan, 1938.*

THE following resolution was duly passed at a meeting of the Wellington City Council held on the 25th day of November, 1937:—

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the provisions of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and its amendments, and of all other Acts, powers, and authorities it in this behalf enabling, the Wellington City Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a special loan of fifty-one thousand pounds (£51,000) to be known as the Wellington City Mercer Street Land Purchase Loan, 1938, authorized to be raised by the Wellington City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of purchasing the land described in subsection (6) of section 67 of the Local Legislation Act, 1928, from the Wellington Education Board, the said Wellington City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of sixty-five sixteen-hundredths of a penny (65/1600d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the City of Wellington, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten (10) years from the 1st day of February, 1938, or until the loan is fully paid off."
