

*Authorizing the Acquisition of Land notwithstanding the Provisions as to Limitation of Area.*

PURSUANT to section two hundred and forty-six of the Native Land Act, 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby authorize the alienation by way of sale to, and the acquisition by, the body corporate called the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City of Auckland, of the lands described in the Schedule hereto, notwithstanding the provisions of Part XII of the Native Land Act, 1931.

SCHEDULE.

(1) All that parcel of land containing 352 acres 2 roods 19 perches, more or less, being the land situate in the Wairoa and Opaheke Survey Districts called Wharekawa No. 4A No. 2, and being the land comprised in a partition order made by the Native Land Court on the 20th day of June, 1913.

(2) All that parcel of land containing 822 acres 2 roods, more or less, being the land situate in the Opaheke Survey District called Wharekawa No. 5B North No. 1, and being the whole of the land comprised and described in Certificate of Title, Volume 283, folio 140, Auckland Registry.

(3) All that parcel of land containing 1,876 acres 2 roods, more or less, being the land situate in the Wharekawa and Opaheke Survey Districts called Wharekawa No. 5B North No. 2, and being the whole of the land comprised and described in Certificate of Title, Volume 280, folio 94, Auckland Registry.

BY virtue of the powers and authorities vested in me by the thirty-fourth section of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, do hereby order and declare that the reserve for recreation in the Auckland Land District described in the Schedule hereto shall be and the same is hereby brought under the operation of and declared to be subject to the provisions of Part II of the said Act, and such reserve shall hereafter form part of the Whakatane Domain, and be managed, administered, and dealt with as a public domain by the Whakatane Domain Board.
