RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

*Footpaths Supplementary Loan, 1937.*

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Gore Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a loan of £600, authorized to be raised by the Gore Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, for kerbing, channelling, and constructing footpaths, the said Gore Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-twentieth of a penny upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Borough of Gore, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the said loan, and be payable half-yearly on the 1st day of August and the 1st day of February in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of eighteen years, or until the loan is fully paid off.”

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Local Government Loans Board Act, 1926, section 23 of the Reserves and other Lands Disposal Act, 1935, section 30 of the Reserves and other Lands Disposal Act, 1936, and of all other powers and authorities thereunto enabling it, the Auckland City Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges in respect of the sum of thirty-nine thousand pounds (£39,000), authorized to be raised by the Auckland City Council under the above-mentioned Acts, for the purpose of establishing on the old railway-station site at Auckland a transport terminus and equipping the said terminus, the said Auckland City Council doth hereby make and levy a special rate of seven-twentieths (7/20ths) of one penny in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of annual value) of all rateable property comprising the whole of the City of Auckland, and that such special rate be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of June in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of fifteen (15) years, or until the whole of the said loan is fully paid off.”
