

AUCKLAND CITY COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Local Government Loans Board Act, 1926, section 6 of the Auckland City and Auckland Museum Empowering Act, 1924, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, the Auckland City Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges in respect of the sum of thirty-four thousand five hundred pounds (£34,500), authorized to be raised by the Auckland City Council under the above-mentioned Acts, for the purpose of repaying, to the extent that related sinking funds are insufficient, the final issue of twenty-five thousand pounds (£25,000) of the Additional Loan, 1883, and the overdraft at the Bank of New Zealand, London, of one hundred and ninety-five thousand nine hundred pounds (£195,900) secured by hypothecated debentures of the Additional Loan 1883 Redemption Loan, 1934, one hundred thousand pounds (£100,000), and the Streets Improvement Loan 1913 Redemption Loan, 1934, one hundred thousand pounds (£100,000), the said Auckland City Council doth hereby make and levy a special rate of nine-twentieths (9/20ths) of one penny in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of annual value) of all rateable property comprising the whole of the City of Auckland, and that such special rate be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of June in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten (10) years, or until the whole of the said loan is fully paid off.”
