APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land proclaimed as road : 2 perches.

Being portion of Section 21, Town of Ahaura.

Situated in Block IV, Mawheranui Survey District (Westland R.D.). (S.O. 3385.)

In the Westland Land District : as the same is more particu-larly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 96016, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, and thereon coloured red.

IN PURSUANCE and exercise of the powers conferred by section twelve of the Land Act, 1924, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim as street the land in the City of Wellington described in the First Schedule hereto; and also do hereby proclaim as closed the street described in the Second Schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

LAND PROCLAIMED AS STREET.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land proclaimed as street: 5-4 percent. Being portion of Section 43, Wadestown, and being part

Section 1, Harbour R.D.; coloured sepia.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

STREET CLOSED.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of street closed: 3 perches. Adjoining or passing through Section 43, Wadestown, being part Section 1, Harbour R.D.; coloured green.

All situated in Block VI, Port Nicholson Survey District. (S.O. 3268.)

All in the Wellington Land District; as the same are more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 98063, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington, and thereon coloured as above mentioned.
