

And whereas the authority conferred by the said Order in Council has not yet been exercised, and it is expedient to vary the determinations aforesaid in respect of the said loan :

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, and in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on him by section eleven of the Local Government Loans Board Act, 1926, as set out in section twenty-nine of the Finance Act, 1932 (No. 2), and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby vary the determinations aforesaid in respect of the said loan by prescribing that in lieu of making provision for the repayment of the said loan by establishing a sinking fund in respect thereof the said local authority may raise the said loan upon terms of making the same, together with interest thereon, repayable by equal aggregate annual or half-yearly instalments extending over the period of twenty (20) years.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Wellington City Council on the sixteenth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven, viz. :—

“ The Wellington City Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the City of Wellington, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to any portion of Little George Street ” ;

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the north-eastern boundary of Little George Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of sixty-six feet from the south-western boundary of the said street.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that street situated in the Wellington Land District, City of Wellington, known as Little George Street, adjoining or passing through parts Sections 642 and 643, City of Wellington.
