THE CENTRAL WAIKATO ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

THAT in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Electric-power Boards' Act, 1925, and all other Acts and powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Central Waikato Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest, sinking fund, and other charges on the Central Waikato Electric-power Board's Special Loan, 1937, £50,000, authorized to be raised by the Board under the above-mentioned Acts and under the Finance Act (No. 2), 1936, for the purpose of further reticulation work within the Central Waikato Electric-power District, the said Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-ninth of a penny ($\frac{1}{9}$ d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of capital value) of all rateable property in the Central Waikato Electric-power District, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of October in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years or until the loan is fully paid off."
