RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Richmond Borough Council hereby resolves as follows :—

RESOLUTION MAKING A SPECIAL RATE.

Mutuera Loan £500.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Waikohu County hereby resolves :—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £500 authorized to be raised by the Waikohu County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of widening and metalling the Mutuera Road, the Waikohu County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of 1½d.
