WAITOMO ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD.

INCREASE IN SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Waitomo Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest, principal, sinking fund, and other charges on the loan of twenty thousand pounds (£20,000) authorized to be raised by the Waitomo Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of providing for extensions and additions to the existing reticulation system and otherwise providing for the distribution of electrical energy throughout the Waitomo Electric-power District, the Waitomo Electric-power Board, pursuant to section 23 of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, hereby increases to one halfpenny in the pound the special rate of 32/88th of a penny in the pound made and levied by resolution passed by the said Board on the 16th day of September, 1935, and gazetted at page 2687 of the *New Zealand Gazette* on the 19th day of September, 1935, on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Waitomo Electric-power District, such rate of 32/88th of a penny in the pound being insufficient to provide for payment of interest, principal, sinking fund, and other charges on such loan, and that such special rate as increased shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of November in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of twenty (20) years or until the loan is fully paid off."
