KNOW YE that We have assigned you and each and every of you, jointly and severally, to be our Justices of the Peace in our Dominion of New Zealand and its Dependencies, to keep and cause to be kept all laws, Ordinances, and statutes in force within our said Dominion for the punishment of offenders, the preserva-tion of the peace, and for the quiet rule, welfare, and good government of our people in our said Dominion; and to have, exercise, and discharge all the powers, authorities, and duties belonging or pertaining to the office of a Justice of the Peace in our said Dominion. And therefore We command you and each and every of you that to keep the peace, and all laws, Ordinances, and statutes, and all and singular other the premises, you diligently apply yourselves, and that, at certain days and places duly appointed or to be appointed for these purposes, into the premises to make inquiry, and all and singular the premises hear and determine, and perform and fulfil them, doing therein what to justice appertains, according to the law and custom of England and of our said Dominion.
