Additional Land at Sawyer's Bay taken for the Purposes of the Waitaki-Bluff Railway.

#### [L.S.] GALWAY, Governor-General. A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS it has been found desirable for the use, convenience, and enjoyment of the Waitaki-Bluff Rail-

way to take further land at Sawyer's Bay in addition to land previously acquired for the purpose of the said railway:

Now, therefore, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on me by sections thirty-four and two hundred and sixteen of the Public Works

Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes above mentioned.
