## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Counties Act, 1920, and the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Amuri County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest and other charges on the Amuri County Council Doctor's House Loan, 1938, of £1,910 authorized to be raised by the Amuri County Council under the above-mentioned Acts for the purpose of erecting a doctor's residence in the Amuri County, the said Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of seven six-hundred-and-twenty-fifths of a penny (7/625d.) in the pound sterling on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the Amuri County, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable annually on the first day of September in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of twenty (20) years or until the loan is fully paid off."
