Lands permanently reserved in the Taranaki and Canterbury Land Districts.

GALWAY, Governor-General.

WHEREAS by the three-hundred-and-fifty-ninth section of the Land Act, 1924, it is enacted that the Governor-General may from time to time set apart temporarily as reserves, notwithstanding that the same may be then held under pastoral license, any Crown lands which in his opinion are required for any of the purposes of the said section mentioned:

And whereas by the three-hundred-and-sixtieth section of the said Act it is provided that land temporarily reserved under the said three-hundred-and-fifty-ninth section may, at the expiration of one month, but not later than six months, after the publication in the *Gazette* of notice of such temporary reservation, be permanently reserved, and that notice of such permanent reservation shall be published in the *Gazette*:

And whereas the lands described in the Schedule hereto were, by the Warrant dated the eleventh day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, and published in the *Gazette* of the seventeenth day of that month, temporarily reserved under the authority of the said Act for the purposes in the Schedule of the said Warrant specified at the end of the respective descriptions of the lands so intended to be temporarily reserved:

Now, therefore, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the said Act, do hereby permanently reserve the lands described in the Schedule hereto for the purposes in the said Schedule specified at the end of the respective descriptions of the lands so intended to be permanently reserved for which purposes the said lands were so temporarily reserved as aforesaid.

SCHEDULE.

TARANAKI LAND DISTRICT.

ALL that area containing by admeasurement 4 acres 0 roods 10 perches, more or less, being Lot 1 on D.P. 5657, and being parts Sections 17 and 18, Block XIV, Ohura Survey District: Bounded towards the north and east by the Tokirima Stream: towards the south-east by other part Section 18, Block XIV, Ohura Survey District, 323.8 links; towards the south-west by Tokirima Road, 930.2 links; and towards the north-west by other part Section 17, Block XIV, Ohura Survey District, 40 links; be all the aforesaid linkages more or less; as the same is delineated on the plan marked L. and S. 6/6/634A, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon bordered red. Increasing Number of Days on which Charges may be made for Admission to the Taihape Oval Domain.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section twenty-three of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby increase the number of days which may be prescribed by the Taihape Oval Domain Board as days upon which charges may be made, pursuant to section twenty-one of the said Act, for admission to the domain described in the Schedule hereto, or to any part thereof set apart for a particular purpose, from twenty days to thirty days during the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine.
