Amending a Proclamation proclaiming a Road-line laid out through Waihapu Blocks, Block I, Kaeo Survey District, North Auckland Land District, to be a Public Road.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the thirteenth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, and published in *Gazette* of the twenty-first day of that month, a road-line laid out through Waihapu Blocks, Block I, Kaeo Survey District, was proclaimed as a public road pursuant to section four hundred and eighty-seven of the Native Land Act, 1931:

And whereas certain errors were made in the description of the said road in the Schedule to the Proclamation hereinbefore referred to, and it is desirable that the said Schedule should be amended:

Now, therefore, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section four hundred and eighty-seven of the Native Land Act, 1931, and of all other powers and authorities enabling me in this behalf, do hereby amend the Proclamation dated the thirteenth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, hereinbefore referred to, by substituting the description of the road set forth in the Schedule hereto for the description of the road set forth in the Schedule to the said Proclamation.

Settlement Lands in Marlborough and Nelson Land Districts proclaimed to be Ordinary Crown Land.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by section forty-nine of the Land for Settlements Act, 1925, as amended by subsection one of section ten of the Land Laws Amendment Act, 1935, it is enacted that the Governor-General may by Proclamation declare any settlement land to be, *inter alia*, ordinary Crown land available for disposal under the Land Act, 1924:

And whereas the lands described in the Schedule hereto are settlement lands within the meaning of the Land for Settlements Act, 1925:

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities so conferred upon me by the aforesaid section forty-nine, amended as aforesaid, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that from and after the date of the gazetting hereof the lands described in the Schedule hereto shall be ordinary Crown land available for disposal under the Land Act, 1924.

MARLBOROUGH LAND DISTRICT.
