

*Motor-vehicles Amendment Act, 1936.—Disallowance of By-laws re Warning Devices.*

**P**URSUANT to section 11 of the Motor-vehicles Amendment Act, 1936, I, Robert Semple, Minister of Transport, being of opinion that the subject-matter of certain parts of by-laws as described in the Schedule hereunder dealing principally with the use of warning devices on vehicles should not be dealt with otherwise than by regulations of general application made under the Motor-vehicles Act, 1924, do hereby disallow the said parts of by-laws, and do hereby declare that such disallowance shall take effect on the day of the publication of this notice of disallowance in the *Gazette*.

*Authorizing the Laying-off of Roads of less Width than 66 ft.*

**W**HEREAS in the opinion of the Minister of Lands it is inexpedient, by reason of the fact that the land shown upon the plan of Town of Omakau Extension No. 2, affecting Section 23, Block VIII, Town of Manuherekiā, is intended to be used wholly for residential purposes, that the proposed road shown thereon should be of the width of 66 ft. :  
Now, therefore, I, Frank Langstone, Minister of Lands, do hereby, in pursuance of the power conferred upon me by section 17, subsection (1) of the Land Act, 1924, and of every other power me therunto enabling, authorize the laying-off of the proposed road of a width of not less than 40 ft. :  
Provided always that it shall not be lawful for any person to erect or cause to be erected any building at a less distance than 33 ft. from the middle of such road.
