Vesting the Control of a Scenic Reserve in the Forest Hill Scenic Board.

# GALWAY, Governor-General.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by section thirteen of the Scenery Preservation Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand doth hereby vest the control of the reserve described in the Schedule hereto (being land reserved under the said Act) for the period of five years from the date hereof (unless previously altered or revoked under the said Act,) in the undermentioned persons, namely,—

The Commissioner of Crown Lands for the Land District

of Southland, ex officio,
His Worship the Mayor of Invercargill, ex officio,
The Chairman of the Southland County Council, ex officio,
Ewen John McLauchlan, and
William Motthers Norman William Matthew Norman,

who are hereby constituted for that purpose a special Board by the name of the Forest Hill Scenic Board (herein referred to as "the Board"), in trust, for the preservation of scenery, and with the powers and subject to the conditions hereinafter

1. The first meeting of the Board shall be held on Thursday, the twenty-fifth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, at two o'clock p.m., in the Land Board Room, Lands and Survey Department, Invercargill, and thereafter the Board shall meet for the transaction of business at such time or place as may from time to time be fixed by

the Board.

2. The members of the Board shall at their first meeting, and thereafter at the annual meeting hereinafter mentioned. elect one of themselves to be Chairman, who may join in the discussion, and shall have an original as well as a casting vote. The Chairman shall hold office until the election of his successor.
