

COROMANDEL COUNTY COUNCIL.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO THE TAKING OF LAND AND TO CLOSE PORTION OF ROAD.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Coromandel County Council proposes, under the provisions of the above-mentioned Acts, to execute a certain public work—namely, the access road to the beach at Mercury Bay through the Kaokaotunoa Block—and for the purposes of such public work the lands described in the First Schedule hereto are required to be taken, and the portion of road described in the Second Schedule hereto is required to be closed.

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OTAGO ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Otago Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing principal, interest, and other charges on the loan of £23,500 authorized to be raised by the Otago Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act for the reticulation, &c., of the Otago Central Area, the said Otago Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of  $\frac{1}{8}$ d. in the pound upon rateable value (capital value) of all rateable property of the Otago Central Area comprising part of the Taieri-Maniototo and Waihemo County Councils specially described in the proclamation in *New Zealand Gazette* dated 26th April, 1929, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st November each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years or until the loan is fully paid off.”
