

OTAKI BOROUGH COUNCIL.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

Otaki Borough Municipal Theatre Supplementary Loan, 1938, of £700.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Otaki Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest, principal, and other charges on a loan of seven hundred pounds (£700) authorized to be raised by the Otaki Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purposes of completing the erection of a municipal theatre, the said Otaki Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-half penny ($\frac{1}{2}$ d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the area now comprising the whole of the Borough of Otaki; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable half-yearly on the first day of December and the first day of June in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten (10) years or until the loan is fully paid off."
