

BOROUGH OF RUNANGA.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Runanga Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of fourteen thousand pounds (£14,000) authorized to be raised by the Runanga Borough Council for the purpose of meeting the cost of water-supply from Coal Creek for the Borough of Runanga, the said Runanga Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of nineteen pence and nine hundred and fifteen thousandths of a penny (19·915d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the Borough of Runanga on the basis of the unimproved value of such property; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 7th day of October in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years or until the loan is fully paid off."
