Amending an Order in Council authorizing the Hume (Cobb River) Electric-power Company, Limited, to use Water from the Cobb River for the Purpose of generating Electricity and to erect certain Electric Lines.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and with the consent of the licensee, doth hereby amend the Order in Council dated the twelfth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five, and published in the *Gazette* of the eighteenth day of the same month, at page 1941 (hereinafter referred to as the "said license"), authorizing the Hume (Cobb River) Electric-power Company, Limited, to use water from the Cobb River for the purpose of generating electricity, and to lay, construct, put up, place, and use certain electric lines; as amended by a further Order in Council dated the nineteenth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the twentieth day of the same month, at page 1611, and further amended by an Order in Council dated the seventh day of October, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the eighth day of the same month, at page 1841; by substituting the words "forty years and five months" for the words "thirty-eight years" in clause five of the said license, and by substituting the words "four years and five months" for the words "three years and one month," at the commencement of clause nine of the said license. Subject to the aforesaid amendments the terms and conditions of the said license are hereby confirmed.
