A PROCLAMATION.

**B**Y virtue and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the Forests Act, 1921-22, and pursuant to a resolution in that behalf passed by both Houses of Parliament, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke (so far only as it relates to the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto) the Proclamation of the third day of May, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, whereby the said land (with certain other land) was set apart as a permanent State forest, and declare that the reservation thereby effected is (so far as aforesaid) revoked accordingly.

SCHEDULE.

WELLINGTON LAND DISTRICT.—WELLINGTON FOREST-CONSERVATION REGION.

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District, Masterton County, containing approximately 32 acres 2 roods, being part of State Forest 31 (*Gazette*, 1934, page 1388), situated in Blocks VI and X, Mikimiki Survey District, and bounded generally as follows: Towards the north-east by Section 1, Block VII, Mikimiki Survey District; towards the south by the Mikimiki Stream; and towards the west by the other part of State Forest 31. As the same is more particularly delineated on plan No. 90/6, deposited in the Head Office of the State Forest Service at Wellington, and thereon bordered red.

As the same is more particularly delineated on plan No. 31/4, deposited in the Head Office of the State Forest Service at Wellington, and thereon bordered red. (Auckland plan S.O. 29572.)
