“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £13,000 authorized to be raised by the Taumarunui County Council under the above-mentioned Act—

“For the purpose of building fifty new bridges in concrete, steel, hardwood, or a combination of those materials, the sum of £10,000;

“For building culverts of a diameter of three feet or larger, in concrete, the sum of £2,000; and

“For building a county office at Taumarunui, in concrete, the sum of £1,000;
