IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section twelve of the Land Act, 1924, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim as street the land in the Borough of Te Kuiti described in the First Schedule hereto; and do hereby proclaim as closed the street described in the Second Schedule hereto; and I do also hereby declare the land contained in the street closed which intersects the portion of the Te Kuiti Domain described in the Third Schedule hereto, to be added to the said Te Kuiti Domain.

*Altering the Boundaries of the Otago Mining District.*

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by section eight of the Mining Act, 1926, it is, *inter alia*, enacted that the Governor-General may from time to time by Proclamation alter the boundaries of any mining district: And whereas it is desirable that the land specified in the Schedule hereto shall, subject to all existing registered mining privileges, be excluded from the Otago Mining District:

Now, therefore, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section eight of the Mining Act, 1926, and of all other powers and authorities in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby, as from the date of the publication hereof in the *New Zealand Gazette*, alter the boundaries of the Otago Mining District by excluding therefrom the land particularly described in the Schedule hereto, subject to all existing registered mining privileges.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that area in the Otago Land District containing by admeasurement 16 acres and 1 rood, more or less, being Section 17, Block X, Kurow Survey District. Bounded towards the north-west by a public road, 843·7 links; towards the north-east by a public road, 1109·0 links; towards the south-east by a public road, 545·2, 954·1, and 345·3 links; and towards the west by Section 3, 1558·7 links; be all the aforesaid linkages more or less.
